

Call to Devotion

"In this world you will have troubles, but rejoice, I have overcome the world."

Јони 16:33

## **PRAYER**

Dear God,

How does this text speak into your life today? Is there a way that rejoicing and delighting in God changes how you view the troubles you are facing right now?


## **ACTION**

Call to Prayer

"Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed."

Mark 1:35

## **PRAYER**

Dear God,

There's a reason Jesus got up and spent time with you under the cloak of darkness. Before the other voices began speaking into his life, before the rush of everything to do, before the expectations of others came moving towards him, he heard from you and spent time in connection and conversation with you. I need this so desperately in my life. I need to hear from you, and to know you hear me. Would you please help me to settle down and be still, to know that you are God (Psalm 46:10).

## REFLECTION QUESTION

## **ACTION**

Open your hands in your lap, bowing your head (and your heart) in a posture of surrender. Begin opening your heart in conversation with God. Pause and listen. Wait before the Lord.

Call to Rest

## **PRAYER**

Dear God,

I affirm today that I am a human being. To be fully human means to live in a rhythm of rest and work, back to the way you designed me to live at creation. ## REFLECTION QUESTION



call to community

## REFLECTION QUESTION



## **PRAYER**

## REFLECTION QUESTION


What does it look like for you to bear witness to God's story through your story? Reflect for a moment on the small and large decisions that you can make in your own life to choose to show up in honest witness.


How do you understand the gospel, the good news, through the life of Jesus? What does 'sharing the gospel' mean in your life?

Call to Bless

## **PRAYER**

# REFLECTION QUESTION
